


## 80's - 90's Tea Tray

Let's Get Started! Elizabeth handed out our kits, which were nicely presented and organized in pretty pink bags!





Lightly sand all wood pieces: tray bottom, sticks, wooden tea pot lid, and slightly round top corners of Tea Pot.

Paint all pieces just sanded with white paint.

Gently re-sand all pieces once the white paint has dried.



You can stand up your sticks (sides of tray) into slits in Styrofoam for ease in drying. Put a dab of Instant Tac on bottom of push pin, and pin into both the tea pot block and the tea pot lid, this will make it easier to hold onto when both sanding and painting.

Take one of the small hole-punch circles and glue it onto the top of the painted tea pot lid, making sure that the hole does not get glue in it! Place the "knob" through the hole in the lid. Pull it back out and cut the stem so that it does not go past the bottom of the lid, otherwise it will not sit "flat" on the tea pot.
