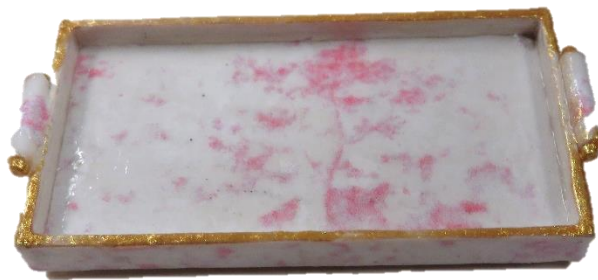


Cut the Toile and cover the tray base, cover the sides and top of the tea pot, but don't cover the "sticks", they will remain white paint on the inside of the tray.

Cut two sticks for the long sides of the tray and glue into place making sure that the sticks go down over the side and are flush with the bottom of the tray. Next, cut the end pieces, which should go across the base and cover the side pieces as well.



Once the sides are on and the glue has dried, wrap the Toile right around the entire outside – you'll probably need two strips.

Use clear nail polish and paint two thin layers onto the tray.

Cut two pieces of Q-tip for handles. They should be just under ½ inch in length. Cover with Toile. Glue onto tray. Lastly, gold the edges with either a gold pen or Elizabeth prefers gold nail polish. I think there are little bead feet too, but we haven't got to the part of the class yet!
